We coordinate with visiting general practitioners and other medical specialists, as needed, to help prevent or relieve the suffering of our residents. Important in this process is the early identification and then treatment of physical, emotional or social symptoms.

Another important part of palliative care is to provide peace of mind to the family, friends and carers of our residents. We not only provide support to these loved ones but we also listen to and respect their wishes. The Hillview team work with residents and their families to answer any questions they may have as they go through this journey.

No two people are the same, which is why HillView cares for residents with life threatening illness based on their individual needs.

We ensure our residents have choices about how they are cared for and supported, just like they would have if they were living in their own home. We also do everything possible to protect the dignity and independence of our residents. Medication is given in the privacy of their own room and our team support them to remain as active and involved in our community as they choose.

Advanced care plans

We recommend residents receiving palliative care work with our team to develop an Advanced Care Plan or Statement of Choice, so family, doctors and staff are aware of the resident's wishes and can make appropriate health care decisions.

This range of expertise combined with our 24 hour on-site nursing care enables HillView to continue to care for your loved one, even as their health declines. HillView also has a quality team of visiting GPs and allied health professionals available to our residents as needed.
